Chronic Wasting Disease Management and Response Funding Opportunities

Funding is available for projects that help States, Tribes, universities, and others control chronic wasting disease in wild and farmed cervids, such as deer and elk.

Plant Pest and Disease Management and Disaster Prevention Program

Funding is available for projects that strengthen and safeguard our Nation's agricultural infrastructure by preventing, detecting, and mitigating invasive plant pests and diseases.
