

Map of Cascadia. Depicts maritime ports of entry for commercial vessels that may be subject to a lower commercial vessel user fee.

The Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) defines Cascadia as “British Columbia and those ports of entry into the United States lying south of 59° 26' 59.316" N, north of 43° 23' 34.152" N, west of 122° 20' 31.2" W, and east of 135° 20' 2.4" W” as shown by the red rectangle in Figure 1. This currently includes the ports of entry shown in Figure 1 and Table 1, which are described in U.S Customs and Border Protection (CBP) regulations in [19 CFR 101.3](#).

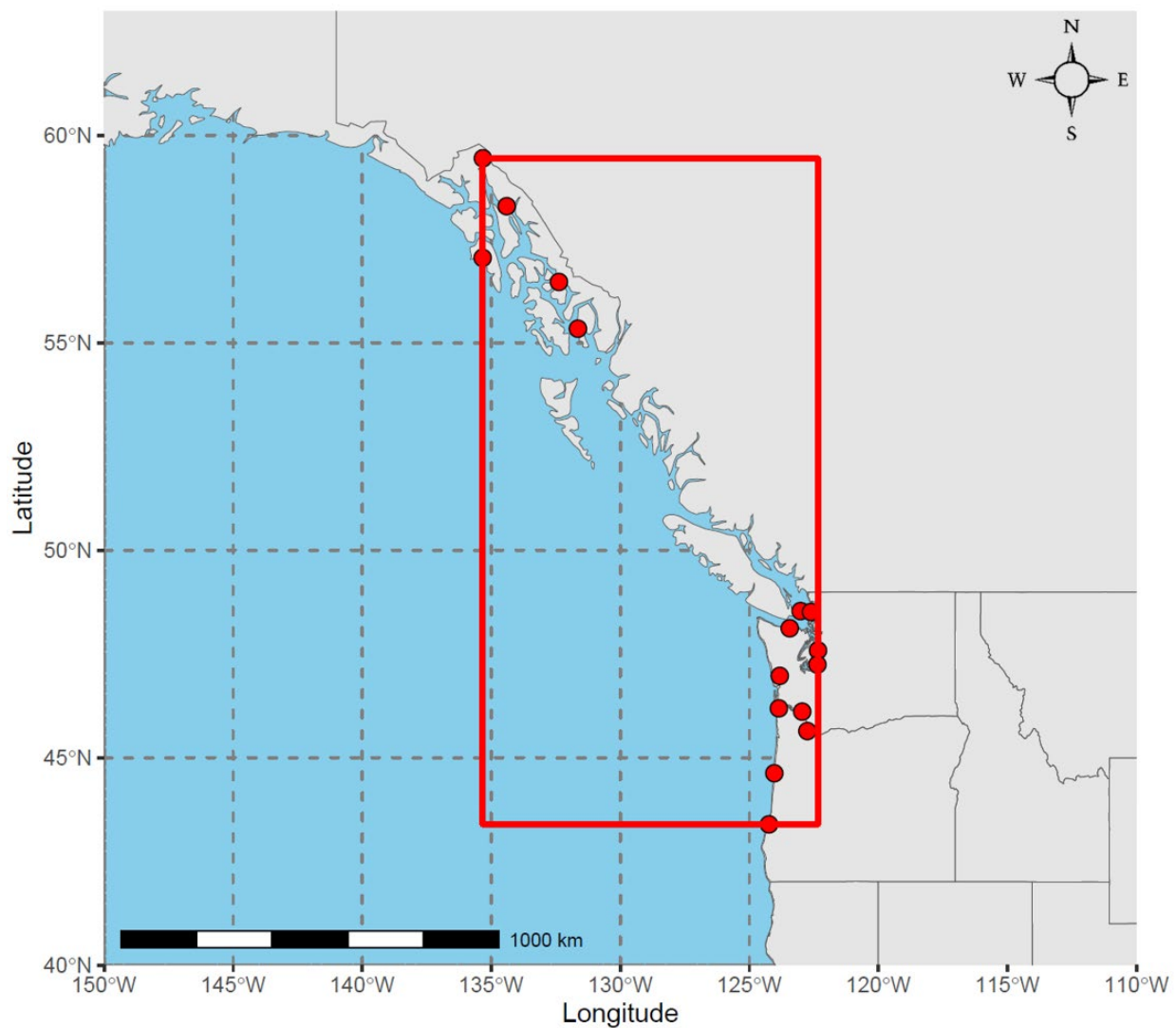
