Plant Protection and Quarantine (PPQ) officials are allocated to oversee removal methods to ensure the disease does not cross quarantine boundaries. If possible, we would like to obtain records of when and where the trees were removed when Citrus Greening or Citrus Canker was present. 3. Records of chemical treatments According to The Asian Citrus Psyllid & Huanglongbing, CDFA - Plant Health - Asian Citrus Psyllid and Huanglongbing - Notice of Treatment and Proclamation of an Emergency Program, and ACP Effective Insecticides - Asian Citrus Psyllid Distribution and Management, APHIS must be involved in the application of insecticides, fungicides, or pesticides that involve chemicals. The chemicals being used have to be labeled and approved by APHIS under The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA). If the chemical is not in the approved database, treatment can not happen until it has been submitted for review and approval. If possible, we would like to obtain records of when and where chemicals were used to control Citrus Greening and Citrus Canker. In addition, which chemicals were used, and what is the application type (foliar, soil, mating disruption, etc.). 4. Records of natural enemy introduction According to Identification and Management of Citrus Greening Disease in Texas and Asian Citrus Psyllid and Huanglongbing Disease Management Guidelines--UC IPM, certain predators such as parasitic wasps and lady beetles target Asian Citrus Psyllid (ACP) populations and decrease the overall population density. If an organism is not native to a region, then APHIS must step in and approve new species' introduction through an environmental review process. If possible, we would like to obtain data on when and where the following procedures were used. 5. Records of Sterile Insect Technique (SIT) According to the Statewide Plant Pest Prevention and Management Program Environmental Impact Report, SIT encourages the sterilization of the pest population through irradiation. Large quantities of sterilized insects are bred by exposing them to low doses of radiation.
