This is to certify:

The poultry described below and the flocks of origin have been inspected and as a result of a careful examination, no evidence of Newcastle disease or any communicable disease of poultry was found nor, insofar as it has been possible to determine, were the poultry exposed to any such disease during the ninety (90)* days immediately prior to the inspection date.

* For HPAI, this time frame is reduced to 28 days.

Poultry were either vaccinated against avian paramyxovirus a minimum of 21 days prior to export with a vaccine that does not contain any velogenic strains OR

were not vaccinated for avian paramyxovirus (delete option not used).

The poultry have not been vaccinated with a vaccine for any H5 or H7 subtype of avian influenza, and have not transited through regions where any HPAI subtype exists while en route to the United States.

For purposes of certification for entry into the United States of America, poultry is defined as chickens, ducks, geese, swans, turkeys, pheasants, grouse partridges, quail, guinea fowl, and pea fowl.
