

Porcine Origin Meat-and-Bone Meal, Meat Meal, Bone Meal, and Lard Not For Human Consumption

These materials may be imported to Taiwan with a VS Form 16-4 with no additional declarations, other than the standard:

“This is to certify that rinderpest, foot-and-mouth disease, hog cholera, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, bovine spongiform encephalopathy, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia do not exist in the United States of America.”

Export certificates for lard must indicate in the “PRODUCT” description box, that the material is either “inedible” or “not for human consumption.”
