

MARKINGS AND LABELING	Transport enclosures must be properly labeled. [3.14, 3.36, 3.61, 3.81, 3.113, 3.137]
Criteria	A removable transport enclosure is properly labeled if it contains: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• markings on the top and one or more sides of the enclosure• directional arrows indicating the upright position• the words<ul style="list-style-type: none">▶ “Live Animal”▶ in letters at least 1" in height▶ on top of the enclosure and on one or more sides
Species Specific	Nonhuman Primates [3.87(f)] Removable and permanently affixed transport enclosures must contain the words in English “Wild Animal” or “Live Animal”. Marine Mammals [3.113(f)] RESERVED-Pending approval of the negotiated rules. Other Animals [3.137(e)] <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The words “Wild Animal” may also be used.
