IMPORT ALERT: Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) restrictions for avian commodities originating from or transiting Kagawa and Tokushima

Issuance Date: January 16, 2018

Effective Date: January 12, 2018

Effective immediately and until further notice, U.S. Department of Agriculture Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) Veterinary Services (VS) is prohibiting the importation of poultry, commercial birds, other types of birds (research, performing), ratites, any avian hatching eggs, unprocessed avian products and by-products, and certain fresh poultry products from Kagawa and Tokushima, prefectures of Japan on Shikoku Island. Any of these commodities originating from or transiting through Kagawa and Tokushima are prohibited entry to the United States, based on an outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza. These restrictions will be updated as we receive additional information on the animal health situation in Kagawa and Tokushima.

Processed avian products and by-products originating from or transiting through Kagawa and Tokushima imported as cargo must be accompanied by an APHIS import permit and/or government certification confirming that the products were treated according to APHIS requirements.

Processed avian products and by-products for personal use originating from or transiting through Kagawa and Tokushima entering in passenger baggage not having a thoroughly cooked appearance, or not shelf-stable as a result of APHIS approved packaging and cooking (i.e. packaged in hermetically sealed containers and cooked by a commercial method after such packing to produce articles that are shelf stable without refrigeration), must also be accompanied by a VS import permit and/or government certification confirming that the products/by-products were treated according to APHIS requirements.

Unprocessed avian products and by-products originating from or transiting Kagawa and Tokushima are not permitted to enter in passenger baggage. This includes hunter harvested, non-fully finished avian trophies and meat.

U.S. origin and non U.S. origin, pet birds, or zoological birds, may be imported from Kagawa and Tokushima with an APHIS import permit. They must undergo a required 30-day quarantine in one of the two USDA Quarantine Centers.
