I. PURPOSE

SUBJECT:

The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties that the Center for Veterinary Biologics (CVB) is accepting veterinary biologics product license and permit applications for Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease Vaccine.

Accepting Product License Applications for Epizootic Hemorrhagic

II. BACKGROUND

Epizootic hemorrhagic disease virus (EHDV) serotypes 1 and 2 have been implicated in epizootics of white-tailed deer in the United States and Canada, with serotype 2 most often implicated. Serotype 6 has been identified from samples collected in several states of the United States. The EHDVs belong to the genus *Orbivirus*, family *Reoviridae*. EHDV is transmitted via a *Culicoides* biting fly or midge. Epizootic hemorrhagic disease (EHD) can have severe disease impacts in wild and captive white-tailed deer.

III. ACTION

The CVB will consider license, including conditional license, and permit applications for Epizootic Hemorrhagic Disease Vaccine. The Serotypes of the included acceptable fractions are limited to those isolated from animals naturally infected in the United States. Interested parties should refer to Title 9, Code of Federal Regulations, Subchapter E; Veterinary Services Memorandum (VS Memo) 800.50, Basic License Requirements for Applicants; and VS Memo 800.101, U.S. Veterinary Biological Product Permits for Distribution and Sale.
