The following information was provided to you as a cover letter to our 2003 annual report. Since our status remains the same, I am again submitting this explanation to you.

Allow me to introduce myself. I am [REDACTED] program on our campus. I am also the veterinary member of our IACUC.

Enclosed you will find the annual report for Oklahoma State University-Oklahoma City, Dept. of Veterinary Technology. If you have occasion to compare it with our 2003 (versus 2002) annual report, you may notice that we are still submitting a "negative report" in that we used no reportable animals this year. Our Animal Care Inspector for this region is Dr. Nancy Ellifrit. She mentioned that this might be noticed in your office and suggested that I enclose this letter of explanation.

Our facility neither owns nor houses the animals we use for teaching purposes. We have partnerships with facilities in our area which allow us to utilize their animals for teaching purposes. A list of the aforementioned facilities is enclosed. After careful evaluation of the status of our partner facilities, Dr. Ellifrit determined that the animals we are using in our teaching are all actually privately owned, with the exception of those animals at Wildlife Rescue *which are destined to be released*. Additionally, because we partner with our parent institution, OSU in Stillwater, and the Univ. of Oklahoma, the animals owned by those two facilities are being accounted for on their annual reports, which has, in the past, caused them to be twice counted for the same event.

Dr. Ellifrit therefore instructed us to only report the numbers of *releasable*, wild animals used for teaching purposes at Wildlife Rescue. This particular facility has not been in operation since our last report. We continue to list it as a partnering facility because the owner does plan to reopen at a later, though undetermined, date. Thus there are no animals to report this year.

We would like to remain registered however. We are an accredited veterinary technology program and our accrediting body, the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) prefers that we are registered. Additionally, because Wildlife Rescue may reopen, we would prefer to be immediately able to use their facility.

If you would like to discuss this reporting change with me, please feel free to do so."
