ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

(1) Each dealer and exhibitor shall employ an attending veterinarian under formal arrangements. In the case of a part-time attending veterinarian or consultant arrangements, the formal arrangements shall include a written program of veterinary care and regularly scheduled visits to the premises of the dealer or exhibitor.

* Program of vet care calls for an annual inspection by the vet of record. Last recorded on site was on 3/3/05 affecting 138 dogs. Correct by 6-17-06.

(3) Daily observation of all animals to assess their health and well-being.

* Boston Terrier # 035 527 380 (Blackjack) was showing a swollen area on the right side of its jaw area. Inspection of the area showed no abscess forming but the area was hard to the touch. Vet of record needs to examine the dog & record all findings and any shot recommendations. Correct by 5-19-06.

* Bulldog # 089 067 261 (Georgous) was showing mattering in both eyes. Licensee needs to start cleaning the eye often enough for the mattering not to form. Correct by 5-24-06.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.


(a) Structure; construction. Housing facilities for dogs and cats must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.

* Outside elevated hutch housing 7 pug dogs, the expanded metal flooring is rusted to the point that holes are starting to form in the flooring. Repair of the flooring is needed before injury occurs. Correct by 6-17-06.



WATERING.


