**OUTDOOR HOUSING FACILITIES.**

Shelters in outdoor facilities for dogs or cats must contain a roof, four sides, and a floor, and must:

(3) Be provided with a windbreak and rain break at the entrance.

\*\*\*There are 15 dog shelters that do not currently have windbreaks on them. Windbreaks are necessary to provide protection from the wind and to prevent rain from entering the shelter. This is extremely important to keep the bedding dry and to help keep the animals warm. This affects 45 animals.

To be corrected by: 14 Feb 2006

(4) Contain clean, dry, bedding material if the ambient temperature is below 50 deg. F (10 deg. C). Additional clean, dry bedding is required when the temperature is 35 deg. F (1.7 deg. C) or lower.

\*\*\* The current temperature out side is 46 degrees F. Several dog shelters do not have bedding in them. Bedding is required when outside temperatures fall below 50 degrees F. This is extremely important for those shorthaired breeds such as the pugs as they tend to get cold easier than longhaired breeds. This affects 10 dogs.
