**3.80 ( b ) ( 2 ) ( iv ) REPEAT NCI**  
**PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.**

Section 3.80(b)(2)(iv) Minimum space requirements: When more than one nonhuman primate is housed in a primary enclosure, the minimum space requirement for the enclosure is the sum of the minimum floor area space required for each individual nonhuman primate in the table in paragraph (b)(2)(i) of this section: each nonhuman primate weighing 1-3 kg. requires at least 3 sq. ft. of floor space.

Nonhuman primates weighing 1-3 kg. are still housed in pairs in enclosures that provided 4.3 sq. ft. in room A2 (10 pairs). The D rooms were corrected. Nonhuman primates weighing 1-3 kg housed in pairs require an enclosure that provides at least 6 sq. ft. of floor space. Animals must be provided with at least their minimum required floor space to maintain their health and well-being.

**3.81 REPEAT NCI**  
**ENVIRONMENT ENHANCEMENT TO PROMOTE PSYCHOLOGICAL WELL-BEING.**

Section 3.81 Environment enhancement: Dealers must develop, document and follow an appropriate plan for environment enhancement adequate to promote the psychological well-being of nonhuman primates.

The facility's plan for environment enhancement states that individually housed nonhuman primates not housed across from each other will have a mirror on the opposite wall. In room A3 there is one wall of enclosures facing a wall with no mirrors. There is still one nonhuman primate housed in an enclosure with no partner and no mirror across from its enclosure. The facility must follow its primate plan for environment enhancement.

Note: the rooms housing 146 primates in quarantine were not entered during the inspection for bio-safety reasons.
