Section 3.50(a) Structural strength: The animal facilities shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals and to restrict the entrance of other animals.

There are still doors in the rabbit area that are rusting through at the bottom. The doors need to be repaired or replaced to maintain the facility in good repair.

**3.56 (d)
SANITATION.**

Section 3.56(d) Pest control: An effective program for the control of mammalian pests shall be established and maintained.

In the barn there are rodent feces on the bags of bedding used in the trays under the rabbit enclosures (also put in the guinea pig enclosures). Some of the bags are torn at the corners and may be housing rodents. An effective pest control program needs to be established to prevent contamination of the bedding with rodents.
