FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

Woodchuck area noted with protruding bolts and old rotted wood. This area needs to be repaired in order to protect the animals from injury.

FACILITIES, OUTDOOR.

The fence must be constructed so that it protects the animals in the facility by restricting animals and unauthorized persons from going through it or under it and having contact with the animals in the facility, and so that it can function as a secondary containment system for the animals in the facility.

Noted in April 05 that a stray fox entered the facility and attacked the facility fox which required veterinary care. The perimeter fence does not provide the protection needed. The fence needs to be repaired.
