

(2) The use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries, and the availability of emergency, weekend, and holiday care.

* Inspection of the 8 tigers took place at the Arab Shriners Circus located in Topeka, Ks. Upon inspection of the tigers, (Massey - female, Obi - male & Rook - male) was showing rub spots on top of there head & along the sides of there eyes. Noticed spots where no hair was present. Tiger handler stated that vet of record had put an antibiotic cream on all 3 tigers prior to coming to Topeka, Ks. This was done on 2/22/06. Tiger handler was not carrying any cream to treat the tigers with. The rub spots were not open sores only sores trying to heal up at the time of inspection. Handler needs to keep all medical records on any treatments performed on the tigers & any letters from the vet of record. Correct by 3-9-06.


(4) Adequate guidance to personnel involved in the care and use of animals regarding handling, immobilization, anesthesia, analgesia, tranquilization, and euthanasia.

* There was no presence of any weapons that could immobilize, tranquilize or euthansia any of the tigers if escape occured for any of the 8 tigers. Licensee must have weapons with the travel exhibitor & have knowledge on how to use such weapons & adminisrate any drugs affecting 8 tigers. Correct by 3-24-06.
