2.40(b)(2) Each dealer or exhibitor shall establish and maintain programs of adequate veterinary care that includes the use of appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat diseases and injuries.

Zada, a female Siberian Tiger, was observed limping on her left front foot. The licensee states that she began doing this yesterday. The licensee has not been in communication with his attending veterinarian nor has the attending veterinarian evaluated this animal.

This does not protect the health and well being of the animal.

Zada must be evaluated by the attending veterinarian and the prescribed treatment must be administered. To be corrected by: September 25, 2006. Number of animals affected: 01.

3.125 (c)

FACILITIES, GENERAL.

3.125(c) Storage. Supplies of food and bedding shall be stored in facilities which adequately protect such supplies against deterioration, molding, or contamination by vermin. Refrigeration shall be provided for supplies of perishable food.

A deer carcass is under the tree waiting to be fed out. Today's temperature is 71 degrees Fahrenheit. Flies and hornets were observed all over the carcass. Additionally, the freezer has two calf carcasses in it. The carcasses are not protected or wrapped and the lid to freezer is open.

This does not protect the food supply from contamination and, therefore, does not protect the health and well being of the animals.

The food supply must be stored in a manner which adequately protects it against deterioration, molding, or contamination. To be corrected by: September 25, 2006. Number of animals affected: 22.

This is a focused inspection dealing with feeding, food storage, and animal health.
