INFORMATION AS TO BUSINESS; FURNISHING OF SAME BY DEALERS, EXHIBITORS, OPERATORS OF AUCTION SALES, INTERMEDIATE HANDLERS, AND CARRIERS.

Each exhibitor shall furnish to any APHIS official any information concerning the business of the exhibitor, which the APHIS official may request in connection with the enforcement of the provisions of the Act, the regulations and the standards in this subchapter.

Poncho appears to be in advanced renal failure. The licensee has, and appears to be continuing to provide veterinary care, and is in contact with the attending veterinarian on a regular basis. The last veterinary exam and lab testing was on or about 10/20/05, and several treatment options have reportedly been explored and implemented since then.

The medical records for this lion that are on-site are, however, incomplete. Several examples of this are: 120 Baytril tablets were dispensed by the attending veterinarian, but only 54 were documented as given to Poncho. A bottle of lixotinic was also dispensed on 10/13/05 and was to be given every day. Only one entry appeared in the record which documents the administration, and the bottle is approx 1/2 empty. The licensee indicated that he was told to discontinue this medication by the veterinarian, but there is no notation of this in the record. The licensee has also indicated that he has also provided other medical care, but the type of care does not appear in any medical records and cannot be determined by this inspector because the licensee could not provide any further information as to these additional treatments.

Complete written medical records shall be readily available & maintained in such a fashion so that they can be reviewed by any APHIS inspector during an animal welfare inspection to ascertain compliance with this section, and to ensure that the veterinarian's recommendations and treatment plans are being implemented and administered by the trainers. The medical records shall also indicate the schedule or time periods for follow-up examinations by the attending veterinarian.
