#### **Procedure to Request Approval to Handle Regulated Garbage**

Any establishment interested in receiving U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) approval to handle regulated garbage should follow the steps below.

## Step 1: Establishment prepares a request for approval packet that includes the following:

- ◆ A signed cover letter requesting approval to handle regulated garbage to the APHIS Administrator
- ◆ A completed Regulated Garbage Compliance Agreement for Approval Template including the core list of requirements as applicable

# Step 2: Official evaluates the request for approval packet and verifies readiness to handle RG.

All required equipment and materials **must** be present at the time of the site visit.

**Step 3: Official recommends approval or denial of request to handle RG.** Final approval or denial will be communicated in writing by APHIS to all parties.

#### **NOTICE**

The establishment is **not** authorized to handle regulated garbage until receiving the official approval letter from APHIS and entering into a compliance agreement.
