

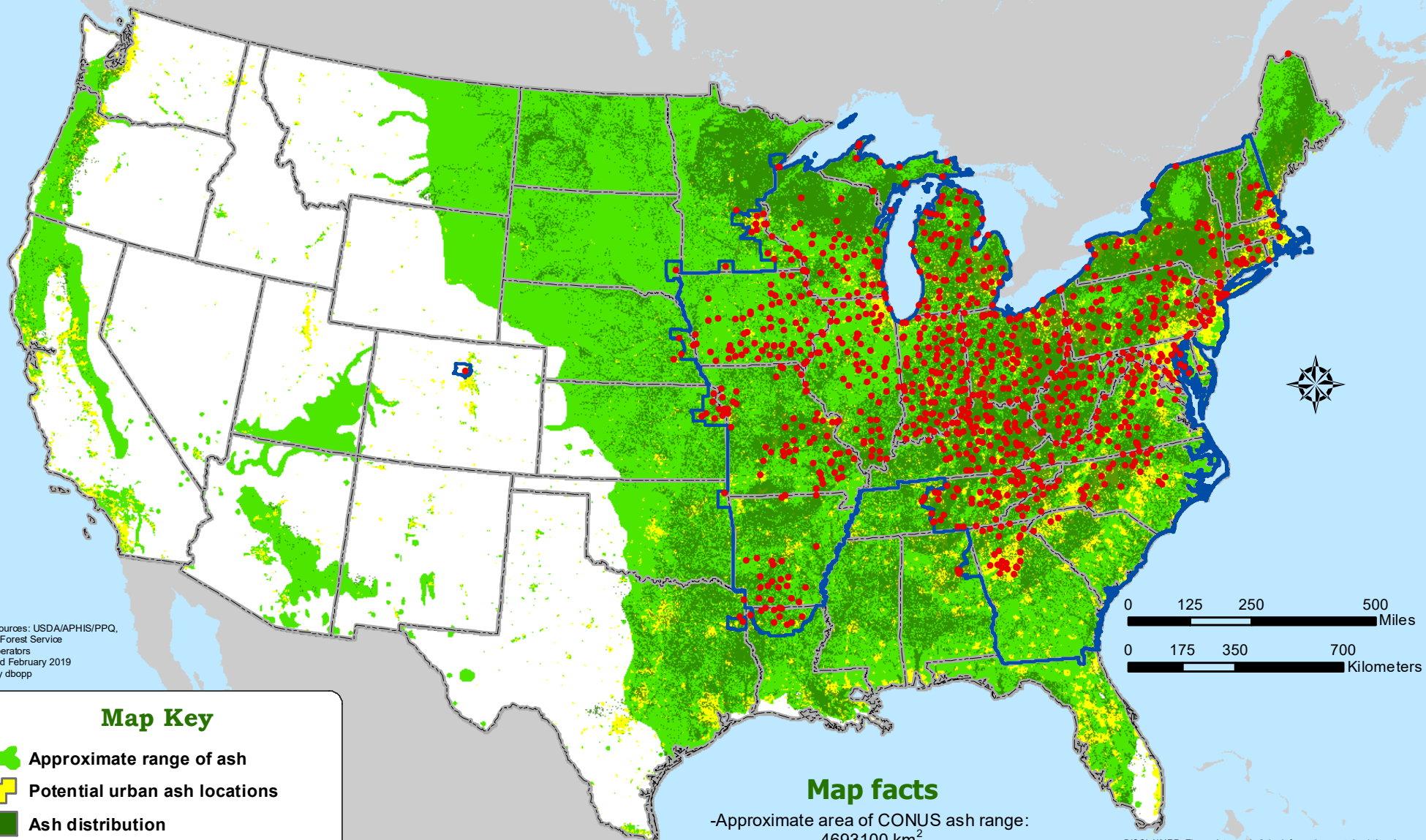

February 1, 2019



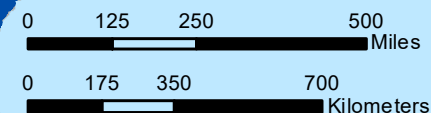
