SUBJECT: Quarantine of entire state of Wisconsin for Pine Shoot Beetle (*Tomicus piniperda*)

TO: STATE AND TERRITORY AGRICULTURAL REGULATORY OFFICIALS

The purpose of this SPRO Memorandum is to provide notification that APHIS is quarantining all counties of Wisconsin for Pine Shoot Beetle (*Tomicus piniperda*). This action is effective immediately. Attached is the Federal Domestic Quarantine Order for the subject action.

FEDERAL ORDER

Domestic Quarantine of entire state of Wisconsin for Pine Shoot Beetle (*Tomicus piniperda*)

This Federal Order provides notification, effective immediately, for quarantine of all counties of Wisconsin for Pine Shoot Beetle (PSB), *Tomicus piniperda*. This action is in response to the decision made by the State of Wisconsin to end intrastate quarantine of counties where PSB has been detected, communicated to U.S. Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, by the Wisconsin State Plant Regulatory Official on 9 January 2006. The 7 CFR 301.50-3(a) allows the quarantine of less than an entire state only when the State enforces an intrastate quarantine that matches Federal Pine Shoot Beetle regulations.

Effective immediately, no person shall move PSB regulated articles interstate from the state of Wisconsin, except in accordance with 7 CFR 301.50. This Order is issued under the regulatory authority provided by the Plant Protection Act of June 20, 2000, as amended, Section 412 (a), 7 U.S.C. 7712 (a), which authorizes the Secretary of Agriculture to prohibit or restrict the movement in interstate commerce of any plant, plant part, or article if the Secretary determines the prohibition or restriction is necessary to prevent the dissemination of a plant pest within the United States.

7 CFR 301.50-3(b) provides for temporary designation of new quarantine areas pending publication of a rule to add counties to the list shown in 7 CFR 301.50-3(c). 7 CFR 301.50-3(b) further requires written notification be given to the owners of property and enterprises in a newly quarantined area, advising them of the quarantine and the necessity of complying with requirements for the movement of regulated articles. This is the responsibility of the Federal and/or State regulatory personnel responsible for the PSB program in the affected state.
