

Solid Wood Packing Material associated with cargo NOT from CHINA or HONG KONG.

1. Free of bark with articles non-regulated cargo (articles not regulated by CFR 319.40)
 - a. Subject to inspection
 - b. Importer's document - "Solid wood packing material is free of bark and apparently free of live insects"
2. Free of bark with regulated cargo (articles regulated by this regulation - Logs/Lumber)
 - a. Subject to inspection
 - b. Importer's document - "Solid wood packing material is free of bark and apparently free of live insects"
 - c. Importer's document certifying that the solid wood packing material was heat treated, fumigated, or treated with preservatives.
3. Not free of bark with regulated or non-regulated cargo.
 - a. Subject to inspection
 - b. Importer's document certifying that the solid wood packing material was heat treated, fumigated, or treated with preservatives.

Solid Wood Packing Material associated with cargo from CHINA AND HONG KONG

1. Prior to export SWPM must be fumigated, treated with heat or treated with preservatives
 - a. Government certificate stating that SWPM has been treated.
 - b. Importer's statement that the certificate is on file
2. SWPM must be safeguarded appropriately
3. Provide documents upon request
4. Importer Options to Expedite shipments
 - a. Provide documents to first POE prior to arrival
 - b. Stamp or mark SWPM with "China Treated"
5. Refusal of Entry
 - a. Shipment contains plant pests
 - b. Contains untreated SWPM - no documents, etc.
6. Actions to be taken
 - a. Re-export Shipment
 - b. Separate SWPM from shipment - at APHIS Inspectors discretion
 - i. Destroy by Incineration or Chipping and Incineration
 - ii. Re-export separated SWPM
