Effective **August 1, 2024,** CDC has new requirements for all dogs entering or returning to the United States. See <u>www.cdc.gov/dogtravel</u> for more information."

APHIS Veterinary Services, along with the CDC, has specific requirements for dogs traveling (imported) to the United States from countries affected by particular diseases such as foot-and-mouth disease (FMD), screwworm, and rabies.

For dog(s) coming from...

• FMD-affected countries (not free), follow the <u>APHIS Veterinary Services import</u> <u>requirements.</u>

- Screwworm-affected countries (not free), follow the <u>APHIS Veterinary Services</u> <u>import requirements</u>.
- Rabies-affected countries (not free), review CDC dog importation regulations .
