- 6. The individual cattle have not been treated with synthetic hormones (except as needed for normal therapeutic treatment) or ractopamine administered by injection or implanted or as a feed additive.
- 7. The cattle have not been fed meat, bone meal or greaves derived from ruminants.

The animals will receive veterinary inspection, within 24 hours of export, and found free of evidence of communicable disease.
