

Dairy for Human Consumption Products Transiting the European Union (EU)

- This reference refers to products intended for human consumption that are only transiting the EU.
- Products must also be accompanied by all certifications required by the pertinent government authorities of the final destination.
- APHIS-Veterinary Services (VS) endorsement of the “**Model Milk-T/S Animal Health Certificate for raw milk or dairy products for human consumption, for [transit] / [storage] (1) (2) in the European Union**” is required if the port of entry into the EU is in Belgium, the UK, or Ireland. Otherwise, Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) or VS may endorse this certificate. However, if AMS or VS endorsement of other certification is required by government authorities of the country of final destination, then that respective agency must provide this certification as part of one certificate for the consignment.

When preparing the certificate:

- Line II.1(b) must be completed as indicated below:

Option One: Heat-Treated Milk Products:

“II.1(b) comply with the relevant animal health conditions for the products concerned as laid down in the animal health attestation in Part II.1 of the model certificates [~~Milk-RM~~]/[~~Milk-RMP~~]/ [~~Milk-HTB~~] / [~~Milk-HTC~~]⁽²⁾ in Part 2 of Annex II to Regulation (EU) No 605/2010;”

Or

Option Two: For aged, raw milk cheeses aged 60 days or more:

“II.1(b) comply with the relevant animal health conditions for the products concerned as laid down in the animal health attestation in Part II.1 of the model certificates [~~Milk-RM~~]/ [~~Milk-RMP~~] / [~~Milk-HTB~~] / [~~Milk-HTC~~]⁽²⁾ in Part 2 of Annex II to Regulation (EU) No 605/2010;”

- Line II.1(c): The date (or date range) of production must be noted in the blank. Exporters must present affidavits supporting this statement (for the lots of products being exported) to the endorsing VS office with the certificate. **For raw**

milk products (when “Milk-RMP” applies in line II.1(b)), the date noted must be at least 60 days prior to export.

Note: All “line-outs” must be initialed by the certificate endorser.
