



ESTABLISHMENT INFORMATION

Submission Type:

New User/Site - For an employee who has never had an APHIS Form 2007 submitted to the CVB for the selected Establishment Site.

Modify Employee Information - For an employee who already has information existing under the selected Establishment Site and the information needs to be updated. This option will pull the existing information for modification. There is the option to change sites by selecting a site from the drop down list in the "Updated Site Address" field, if there is no change to the site then this field will be the same as the "Current Site Address" field.

Inactivate User - For an employee who is no longer employed or no longer needs access to the NCAH Portal. This option will also pull the existing information from the CVB database and will automatically terminate access to the NCAH Portal upon submission to the CVB.

Reactivate User - For an employee who previously was employed at the establishment and site, this will reactivate the employee for the site chosen. Employee and Employment Information as well as Education History may be updated prior to submission.

Establishment - Select from the list of manufacturers. This list is populated by the active manufacturers the current portal user is assigned to within the CVB database.

Current Site Address - Provide the physical address of the applicant's main work duty station. All licensed sites will appear in the drop down list.

Updated Site Address - The ability for an employee to switch sites if already active at the establishment. The updated site must be on the same establishment license.

- Users who did not have a verified identity USDA eAuthentication account prior to the implementation of Login.gov need to create a Login.gov account where a username is assigned upon creation. Prior to use of this username, you must verify your identify.

Allow Portal Access? - This field allows employers to determine if the employee shall have access to the NCAH Portal. This field allows a user to have access to one establishment, while possibly not at another establishment (Site Specific access). Specific portal access roles will be based upon duties/roles, as show in the Employment Information Section of this document.
