There were 12 surveillance inspections conducted at 12 different sites for a total of 104 fish sampled this month. Samples are targeted to moribund and fresh mortalities when possible. The water temperatures continued to rise in response to the warmer air temperatures. All sites with fish in the water remained Category 1 and were scheduled for monthly sampling. Routine harvest continued and spring stocking was completed. No cages were confirmed positive this month.
