There were 11 surveillance inspections conducted at 10 different sites for a total of 55 fish sampled this month. Samples are targeted to moribund and fresh mortalities. The water temperatures continued to increase in response to warmer air temperatures. Routine harvest continued and spring stocking was completed. One Category 2 site was identified and is scheduled for biweekly sampling. All other sites with fish in the water remained Category 1 and were scheduled for monthly sampling.
