There were 10 surveillance inspections conducted at 8 different sites for a total of 55 fish sampled this month. Samples are targeted to moribund and fresh mortalities when possible. The water temperatures remained low in response to cold air temperatures. Seven of the 8 sites with fish in the water remained Category 1 and were scheduled for monthly sampling. One Category 2 (suspect) site was scheduled for biweekly sampling. No cages were confirmed positive this month.
