There were 8 surveillance inspections conducted at 7 different sites for a total of 50 fish sampled this month. Samples are targeted to moribund and fresh mortalities when possible. The water temperatures continued to increase in response to the warmer air temperatures. Six of the 7 sites with fish in the water remained Category 1 and were scheduled for monthly sampling. One site was identified as Category 2 (suspect), will be sampled biweekly, and continues routine harvest. No cages were confirmed positive this month.
