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The official veterinarian certifies for export that all commercial birds covered under this health certificate were inspected by the examining veterinarian issuing the health certificate and:

1. The commercial birds were not vaccinated against any H5 or H7 subtype of avian influenza.
2. The commercial birds presented no evidence of communicable disease of poultry within the 30 days prior to export.
3. The commercial birds do not originate from, nor have they transited through, any region which APHIS considers affected with highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI).
4. The commercial birds were not exposed to active cases of HPAI or Newcastle disease on the premises where they were kept, or on adjoining premises, during the 90 days immediately preceding export.
5. The commercial birds (*choose option below*):
 - Were not vaccinated against Newcastle disease (avian paramyxovirus).
 - OR**
 - Were vaccinated against Newcastle disease at least 21 days prior to export using vaccines that do not contain any velogenic strains of Newcastle disease virus.

7. The commercial birds were placed in new or appropriately sanitized packaging materials at the premises from which the birds were to be exported.
