


Guidance for Using the History of Requirement Updates for Live Animal Exports Webpage:

1. **Filter by Commodity (Type of Animal)**: In order to show all changes to export requirements for a specific **commodity**, choose the **type of animal** from the “View by Commodity” drop down menu, on the left-hand side below, just above the chart.


Note: Filters will only be performed on the specific **type of animal** you have selected from the drop down menu. If you would like to search for updates on more than one type of animal, please select “View all” from the “View by Commodity” drop down menu.

2. Filter by **Commodity (Type of Animal) AND Country**: In order to show all changes to export requirements for a specific commodity to a specific country, choose the type of animal from the “View by Commodity” drop down menu, on the left-hand side. Then, type the name of the country of destination into the Search box on the right-hand side below, just above the chart.

3. **General Search**: In order to search for a specific commodity, country, and/or update, use the **Search** box, on the right-hand side to find updates for a specific **type of animal**, **country of destination**, and/or recent update made.

4. **Sort Column Headings:** When viewing the History of Requirement Updates for Live Animal Exports, you will find the following column headings:

- Date: MM/DD/YYYY
- Country (Ex: Argentina, Brazil, Canada)
- Commodity Category (Ex: Cattle/Bovine, Sheep, Equine/Horses)
- Commodity Detail (Ex: Bovine - Semen, Swine - Embryos, Tilapia)
- Action Performed (Ex: New Health Certificate, Updated Health Certificate, Trade Restriction - Modified)

You can also sort each column heading chronologically (most recent or less recent) or alphabetically (from A to Z, or from Z to A) by clicking on the up/down arrows to the right of the column headings. *Note:* Column headings can only be sorted one at a time.
