

National Veterinary Stockpile (NVS) provides emergency 3D commercial support services to National Centers for Animal Health (NCAH) during Ames, Iowa floods. On August 11, the NVS provided assistance to NCAH in response to local flooding that knocked out the city's water supply to the Ames facility. The NVS identified one of its 3D commercial providers to source and deliver 50,000 gallons of non-potable water per day to keep the facility's cooling tower operating. The provider is also identifying a source for 250,000 gallons of potable water per day until the city is able to fix its broken water main in 4-5 days.
