Supplement 4 Proactive Product-Specific Risk Assessments

The University of Minnesota and Centers for Epidemiology and Animal Health in collaboration with representatives from the U.S. egg industry completed a series of proactive risk assessments (RAs) to estimate the risk of highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) transmission to epidemiologically linked poultry premises through the movement of various egg industry products and associated handling materials. RAs have been developed for the following products:

- Pasteurized Liquid Eggs
- Non-Pasteurized Liquid Eggs
- Washed and Sanitized Shell Eggs
- Nest Run Shell Eggs
- Layer Hatching Eggs
- Layer Day-Old Chicks
- Egg Shells
- Inedible Eggs.
