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Submission of APHIS Forms Used for Export of Veterinary Biologic

Products

I. PURPOSE

SUBJECT:

The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties that the address of the Center for Veterinary Biologics has been changed on APHIS Forms 2017, 2046, 2046-S, 2047, and 2047-S which are used by veterinary biologics manufacturers to facilitate export of their products to foreign countries.

II. BACKGROUND

On July 13, the CVB moved its facilities to 1920 Dayton Avenue, Ames, Iowa. The address of the CVB has been changed on APHIS Forms 2017, 2046, 2046-S, 2047, and 2047-S, which are provided online, to reflect this new address. III. POLICY

Veterinary Biologics firms that submit any of the above listed export forms to the CVB for processing will be allowed a grace period of 60 days from the date of this notice in which they may submit forms using the old address. After that time, submissions using the old address will be returned.

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
