Dear Dr. Goldentyer,

I am providing the Eastern Region Animal Care office a supplement to Purdue University's 2007 Annual Report. Purdue University's Registration Number is 32-R-0007. The Annual Report was completed and submitted in Final Form via electronic submission on November 19, 2007.

The electronic submission process did not allow for attachment of a summary of any IACUC approved exceptions to the regulations or standards.

The Purdue University IACUC has granted one exception to the standards. Title of the approved protocol is Veterinary Clinical Sciences 518 and 520 Small Animal Surgical Laboratory.

The IACUC has approved the temporary holding of dogs in surgical recovery cages with smaller floor space than required by the regulations. Dogs are received at approximately 7:00 a.m. on the day of surgery and are held in the cages until approximately 12:00 noon. The dogs are then used in a non-survival surgical procedure. While the cages provide space for the dogs to make postural adjustments, the cages do not meet the criteria necessary for routine housing.

In the past year (October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007) 109 dogs were affected by this exception.



Exception report:

1. Study MD2561R - This study is approved for chairing a primate for three days if required for emergency medical treatments. The attending veterinarian would determine the necessity of chairing the monkey for treatments. No such treatments were needed during this reporting period.
2. Study MD2774 – This study is approved for suspending lambs in a padded sling because they will have multiple transthoracic pressure monitoring lines and mechanical pump control lines which will be critical to performance of the study. g. The sternal and groin incisions will be padded where they contact the sling. After further recovery, when the animal is capable of standing on it's own, it will be moved to an adapted metabolic cage that prevents side to side and front to back movement. The animal will be able to stand or lay down. The pump drive cable and monitoring cannulas will be suspended to allow up and down movement, and the animal will be placed in a jacket to prevent access to the cable and cannulas. Zero animals were used on this study during this reporting period.
3. Study 2909 – This study is approved to keep lambs in metabolic cages 1- 7 weeks (until venous gradients are established and maintained) due to the sensitivity of the monitoring lines with in the first weeks of the study. These are especially sensitive to free movement of the animal and would benefit from mild restriction i.e. metabolic cages. This adaptation is due to the importance of the monitoring lines in the success of the original protocol. Advancement of line care and patency is ongoing however they wish to achieve the best results while maintaining the safety of the animal. If they have unlimited access to the lines (i.e. standard housing immediately) then the animals are at an increased risk for exsanguination or infection. Once the lines exit from the skin they are group together and wrapped in Vet wrap. These are then covered with a soft cotton cloth to try and prevent any chewing, rubbing and or dislodgment with animal movement.
4. The Laboratory Animal Resource Center has an "Exercise Exemption for Dogs Used in Radioactive Studies" and "Exercise Exemption for Dogs Housed in Recovery Room Cages". The IU School of Medicine IACUC reviewed and approved both standard operating procedures during the November 14, 2007 meeting.
