2.31 (e)

INSTITUTIONAL ANIMAL CARE AND USE COMMITTEE (IACUC).

Section 2.31(e) IACUC: A proposal to conduct an activity involving animals or to make a significant change in an ongoing activity, must contain: (2) A rationale for the appropriateness of the species to be used; (3) A complete description of the proposed use of the animals.

Animal activity proposal (b)(4) A new species was indicated in the proposal with no explanation for adding the new species. The description of the animal activity refers to the facility's Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). However, the new species is not included in the facility's SOPs. The proposal must include a rationale for the new species selected and a complete description of the proposed animal use for the new species.

2.33 (a) (1)

ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.

Section 2.33(a)(1) Veterinary Care: Each research facility with a part-time attending veterinarian or consultant arrangements shall have a written program of veterinary care.

The written program of veterinary care needs to include all the animals housed at the research facility. The facility's written program of veterinary care needs to be updated to include dogs.

3.8 (c) (2)

EXERCISE FOR DOGS.

Section 3.8(c)(2) Exercise for dogs: Research facilities must develop, document and follow an appropriate plan to provide dogs with the opportunity for exercise. If a dog is housed, held or maintained at a facility without sensory contact with another dog, it must be provided positive physical contact with humans at least daily.

One dog is housed alone in a room. Facility personnel are providing the dog with extra human physical contact, but the facility's dog exercise plan does not address a dog housed alone. The facility's dog exercise plan needs to be updated to document the additional care facility personnel are to provide for a dog housed alone.
