A male beagle dog, identified as #2145, in room D-19, had heavy dental calculi on his molar teeth and corresponding mild to moderate periodontal disease.

It is important to the health and well being of the research animals to have effective systems in place to accurately measure and evaluate health and disease states.

Beagle, # 2145, should have a professional dental evaluation as soon as possible and follow-up dental prophylaxis as deemed necessary.

CLEANING, SANITIZATION, HOUSEKEEPING, AND PEST CONTROL.

(c) Housekeeping for premises. Premises... must be kept clean and in good repair...

The dirty side of the cage wash room floor had a noticeable build-up of dirt where the cages were acid washed in the corner away from the entry point of the cage wash machine.

It is important to keep areas adjacent to animal holding rooms as clean as possible for the health and well being of the animals.

The floor in the dirty side of the cage wash room should be cleaned as often as necessary to prevent the build-up of dirt on the floor.
