The counter in the room housing 6 non human primates needs to be cleaned . This area is being used to prepare fruit for the animals. There are dirty utensils and the absorbant paper on the counter is dirty . Food prep should be done outside the animal rooms and all counters and surfaces in the animal room kept clean and free of clutter to maintain husbandry practices.
