**Nature of Activities relating to Compliance Agreement request:**

AgTerra coordinates the variety trials for various beet sugar companies for the purpose of evaluating varieties for suitability in the facility’s growing area. The seed companies participating in the trial send samples of their varieties to AgTerra. AgTerra re-packages the seed and re-labels the samples with a code so that the cooperator who plants the seed in the trials does not know the variety or from which seed company it originated (i.e, a blind study). A captive sample may be kept by AgTerra for quality control purposes. The trials are monitored and evaluated throughout the growing season by sugar company employees or agents and seed company personnel and in the fall the trials are harvested and samples processed and analyzed. The results of any observations or analyses are sent to AgTerra for compilation and analysis. In some cases brei extract from the harvested root samples are also sent to AgTerra for chemical analysis; these results are included in the overall evaluation. The sugar company may also request laboratory analyses on the seed (biological / germination studies or chemical analyses for seed coatings), which AgTerra may conduct itself or coordinate the analysis thereof with a qualified facility. Once the data from the trials and associated analyses has been collected, compiled and analyzed the ‘code’ is broken and the results made available to the stakeholders. AgTerra does not control, monitor or oversee the seed or the seed planting once the coded seed samples are shipped and received by their intended recipient; nor does AgTerra at any time own the seed or plant or oversee planting any seed for root production.
