**We are providing additional information on for importation and movement of H7-1 seed**

**H7-1** seed will be moved to individual WSG grower locations (list and addresses previously sent) under the Wyoming Sugar Growers LLC Compliance Agreement.

- 1) The following entity will deliver H7-1 seed from their location to individual grower locations for planting in research portions of their individual farms. [Redacted] location is [Redacted] WY [Redacted] WY [Redacted] assists with planting trial plots (release) of the seed at the individual grower locations.
- 2) Growers will pick up seed at the following seed dealer location and then transport the H7-1 seed to their individual grower locations. The seed will be properly sealed in containers for transport.

- 3) This transportation of the H7-1 seed would occur along the following highways and roads in Wyoming to their final grower destination. Wyoming Highways [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Fremont County [REDACTED] Washakie County [REDACTED]
- 4) As previously reported, the total H7-1 seed requirements will be approximately 5,000 units and if replanting due to spring conditions is warranted, we will amend this Compliance Agreement to reflect this additional H7-1 seed requirement. H7-1 seed movement will commence in March 2011 and conclude by June 1, 2011.
