

In many instances, more than a single type of resource benefits from operational management activities. Wildlife Services protects resources through implementation of integrated wildlife damage management programs.

WS' operational activities to protect agriculture include protecting livestock and aquaculture from predators; managing invasive species; managing beaver damage; managing wildlife species such as starlings, blackbirds, vultures, and waterfowl; controlling and eliminating wildlife rabies; and other wildlife disease activities.
