

## 2012 Exceptions to Animal Welfare Regulation (Species, Number, Brief Summary)

### **Water Restriction:**

#### 45 Non-Human Primates

These animals underwent varying degrees of water provision as motivation for behavioral task performance. The animals had the opportunity to earn as much fluid as they wish during testing sessions. Veterinarians routinely evaluated the animals to ensure that no animal became dehydrated or exhibited adverse physiology due to metered water provision.

### **Single Housing:**

#### 6 Non-Human Primates

These animals underwent surgery and were housed singly to prevent trauma to the surgical site by cage mates. All animals received enhanced enrichment to include such things as continuous auditory, olfactory, visual contact with conspecifics, daily human interaction and regular novel treats and enrichment.

#### 1 Non-Human Primate

In order to protect the animal during periods of potential impairment, this animal was singly-housed for up 3 days as necessary to monitor for seizure activity and sedating effects of therapeutic drugs. All animals received enhanced enrichment to include such things as continuous auditory, olfactory, visual contact with conspecifics, daily human interaction and regular novel treats and enrichment.

#### 12 Non-Human Primates

These animals were singly housed under conditions to prevent infection of other animals. All animals received enhanced enrichment to include such things as daily interaction and regular novel treats and enrichment.
