The Code of Federal Regulation (9 CFR), Subpart B, Sections 2.25 and 2.30 states that all registrants must update the information on their registration every 3 years.

Please note that unless you have a full-time veterinarian on staff, you must have an approved, complete and up-to-date program of veterinary care form (PVC) on file at your place of business. You can obtain blank PVC forms -- or any other forms you may need -- directly from this office or your USDA inspector. The AWA also requires that you report to us any changes in your name, address, location, management, control or ownership of your business via Mail within 10 days after the change has occurred.
