Dear Mr. Cardon:

This is in response to your March 10, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, which was received in this office on March 11, 2010 and assigned case number FOIA 10-291. You requested a list of all (FOIA) requests the USDA APHIS received from January 1, 2009 to date of response.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located 123 pages of responsive releasable records which are contained on the enclosed CD-ROM. However, names have been withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our denial of this information. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Send to:
