Dear Mr. Cunningham:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated April 8, 2010, which was received in this office on April 8, 2010 and assigned FOIA case number 10-360. You requested a copy of the incident report written by Dr. Dale Weinmann APHIS veterinary employed at the USDA New York Animal Import Center, 474 International Boulevard in Rock Tavern, New York, detailing the facts and circumstances surrounding an accident on March 27, 2010 that resulted in the euthanasia of one thoroughbred horse "KOREA SUN." We apologize for the delay in processing your request.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located responsive records, which include two pages of correspondence. However, we have withheld information under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Certain personal information, such as names, was redacted from these pages.

You may appeal our partial denial of this information. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Send to:
