Agency employees conducted a search of their files and located 68 pages of responsive records on the enclosed CD-ROM. A review of the responsive records indicate that portions of these records are withheld under 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(4), because they contain commercial and/or financial information obtained from a person as privileged or confidential. Also, portions of these records are withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

If you are not satisfied with this response to your request, you may appeal within 45 calendar days from the date of this letter stating the reasons why the requested information should be released under the Act; and why the denial may be in error. Address your written appeal to the: Administrator, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Ag Box 3401, Washington, D.C. 20250-3401. Please refer to FOIA 10-410 in your appeal letter and add the words **FOIA Appeal** to the front of the envelope.
