Dear Ms. Ames:

This is in response to your June 7, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, regarding a list of the locations in which the Wildlife Service Conducted nuisance goose captures in 2009. Your request was received in this office June 8, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 10-486.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located 117 pages of responsive releasable records which are on the enclosed CD-ROM. However, names, identifying titles, and phone numbers have been withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our partial denial of this information. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter. Send to:

By opening rp505enu.exe and following the on-screen instructions, you will install Adobe Reader. After the installation, the Adobe Reader should render the PDF files correctly
