Dear Ms. Burdulis:

This is in response to your November 18, 2010, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all records on file with United States Department of Agriculture, pertaining to Leah Shattuck; dba Winterhill Kennel/Farm. Your request was received in this office on November 18, 2010, and assigned case number FOIA 11-092.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located three documents that are responsive to your request. However, information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

Information has also been withheld under FOIA Exemption 7(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C). This exemption protects from disclosure records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes when its release could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received at the following address within 45 days of the date of this letter:
