This is a final response to your January 18, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for Annual Report of Research Facility (APHIS Form 7023) for the most recent year and for 2005 for the following institutions:


University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA)

Los Angeles Biomedical Research Institute (Harbor-UCLA Medical Center)

Your request was received in this office on January 18, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-196. We apologize for the delay of your request.

Please find enclosed the remaining four documents responsive to your request. However, information is also being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The same information is also being withheld under FOIA Exemption 7(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C). This exemption protects from disclosure records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes when its release could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

In addition, information is being withheld under Exemption 7F of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(7)(F) respectively. Exemption 7F protects from disclosure law enforcement –related information, which if disclosed could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of an individual.

No records were located for the research facility named Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center (a.k.a. UCLA Medical Center), is not registered with Animal Care.

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
You may appeal our partial denial of information and/or findings of no additional records. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received within 45 days of the date of this letter to:
