This is the second partial response to your February 24, 2011, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all photos, videos, DVDs or CDs generated that are related to USDA-licensed commercial facilities in the state of Iowa during the time from January 1, 2009 – February 1, 2011. Your request was received in this office on February 24, 2011, and assigned case number FOIA 11-282. We apologize for the delay of this response.

Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and located on the enclosed CD-ROM 250 pages of documents and photos that are responsive to your request. However, information has also been withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

You may appeal our partial denial determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received at the following address within 45 days of the date of this letter:


